Have questions about transition?

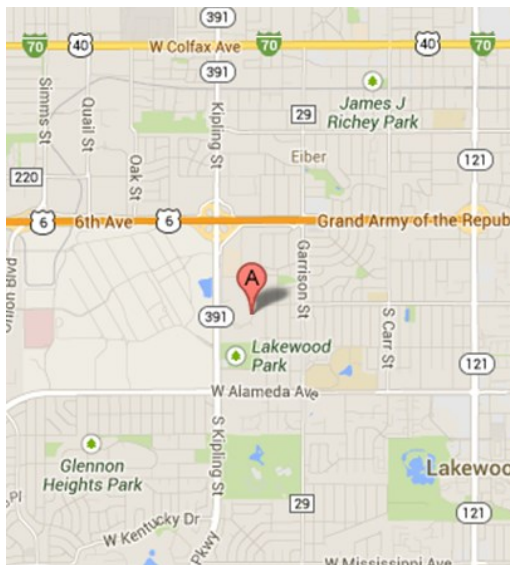
