

AUDITORY TRAINING & SOUND THERAPY

AUDITORY INTEGRATION TRAINING (AIT) was designed to normalize hearing. Distortions in hearing can sometimes be a significant contributing factor in the conditions listed above. Individuals with the abovementioned disorders can often have hearing that is disorganized, asymmetrical, hypersensitive or otherwise abnormal.

SOUND THERAPY Sound Therapy may offer a person with autism the opportunity to “re-open” the listening capacity. The fluctuating sounds produced by the Electronic Ear may gradually exercise and tone the ear muscles, teaching the ear to respond to and recognize the full range of frequencies.
